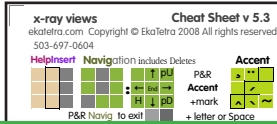


EkaPad tool: Cheat Sheet Neighborhood Map

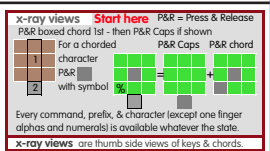
Accent & Navig (lime)

Accent gets you accented letters such as é, ö & Ñ.
 Navig (navigation) lets you control the curser via the EkaPad, making arrow keys.



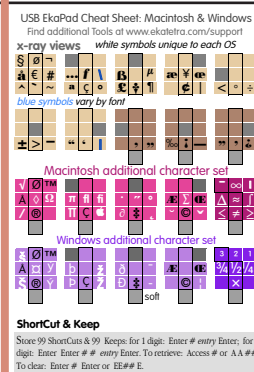
Alpha (blue)

Chords for the all the alphabet, common punctuation, & frequently used symbols.



Uncommon Symbols (brown)

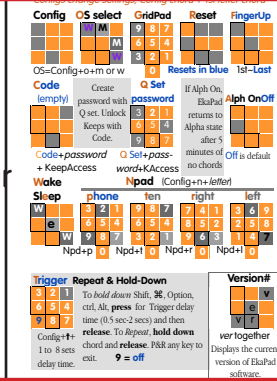
Chords for ¥, §, f, & many others.
 (bright pink) more Mac symbols
 (purple) more Windows symbols

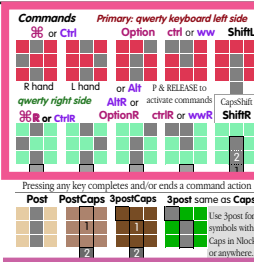
Config (orange)

These chords configure the EkaPad to your preferences

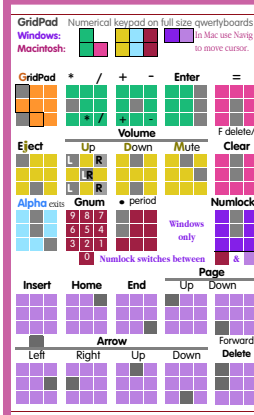


Command & Control (red pink & mist green)

Both left and right control and command keys

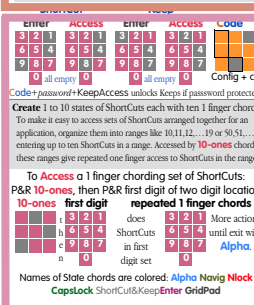
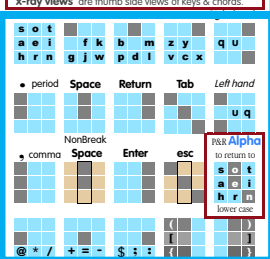
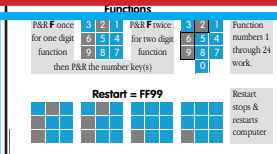


Prefix chords (brown, green)



GridPad (multi colored)

GridPad lets the EkaPad chords carry out the functions of the keys found on the 10-key number pad and special keys at the right end of a 101 key keyboard.



Function & Restart (bright blue)

Chords for 24 functions.
 Keyboard restart for when your computer freezes.



Relic (purple)

Special older key actions, like Print Screen.



ShortCuts, Keeps & 10-ones (soft pink)

ShortCuts have 100 registers which can store command and control chord sequences.
 Keeps have 100 registers which can store short or long character strings up to a combined total of 50,000 characters.
 10-ones lets you put ShortCuts into sets of single finger chords.
