

The quick start way to learn the alphabet while getting accustomed to the EkaPad.

With the tools available at ekatetra.com/support, you can start using the EkaPad immediately.

Once you've used this alphabet chart for a short while you may want to start using the **Cheat Sheet**. Instead of 26 different icons, one for each letter, the same information is displayed in only 5 (or 6) condensed icons. The Cheat Sheet also contains many more icons which show all the letters, numbers, symbols, commands, storage and personal configuration chords available with the EkaPad.
